Dade County Police Benevolent Association Endorses Lisa Lesperance

MIAMI-DADE – Lisa Lesperance, the Democratic Party nominee in the open Florida House District 117 race, received the endorsement of the Dade County Police Benevolent Association (PBA).

“The men and women in law enforcement are my brothers and sisters,” Lesperance said, “I’m deeply honored to have them stand with me in this race and I’ll be just as honored to stand with them in Tallahassee.”
